Please review these important guidelines from the Virginia State Board of Elections.

### 2010 Petition Guidelines

1. As a circulator of a petition you must be a person who is, or who is eligible to be, registered and qualified to vote for the office for which the petition is circulated.
2. Signers must be registered voters inside the 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District. (Persons that will be 18 by November 2010 election are eligible to sign).
3. As the circulator of a petition, you cannot sign or notarize the petition you are circulating and you must **personally witness** the affixing of signatures
4. All circulators must fill out information on bottom of back page of petition.
5. All petitions (even if not complete) must be notarized.
6. A petition can never be left unattended, i.e., left on the counter at a grocery store, restaurant, etc.
7. A separate petition must be used for each city/county. For example, a Chesapeake resident cannot sign a petition designated for Chesterfield. *(If your petition is designated at the top for 'City of Chesapeake' simply cross it out and write-in the appropriate location.)*
8. Social Security numbers are not required and providing the last four digits is optional.
9. All petitions must be printed on legal paper, complete with front and back.
10. All petitions must be turned into Forbes for Congress by March 1, 2010. Please mail to Forbes for Congress, P.O. Box 15100, Chesapeake, VA 23328.
